

Please Note

That the waste must not differ from that described above. Any change in the waste must be notified to the Council in advance of the collection.

Contamination: If your trade bin is contaminated with the wrong items we are unable to collect it. If you have been issued with a red card because of contamination and you require us to return to collect your bin, charges will apply.

South Norfolk Council as a carrier, undertakes to dispose of the waste described above in accordance with our Duty of Care under the Environmental Protection Act 1990. The Duty of Care is a law which says that you must take all reasonable steps to keep waste safe. If you give waste to someone else, you must be sure they are authorised to take it. If you break this law you can be fined an unlimited amount.

Please read this form carefully and make sure that the information provided is correct. You should keep your copy of this form for a period of two years from the date of issue. Keep the top copy and send the signed bottom copy in the self-addressed envelope provided.

This form must be returned within 14 days of issue or your collection will be suspended until the form is returned to comply with the law.
