

# Best Value Review Programme and Statutory Information

## Best Value Review Programme 2006-07

Implementing the findings from the Best Value Review of Support Services, (undertaken in 2005-06) and completing the Access to Services Review will have implications for a number of the council's services. There is also the possibility of more fundamental change through local government reorganisation. We will revisit the review programme when these factors are better known.

### **The Code of Practice on Workforce Matters in Local Authority Service Contracts**

South Norfolk Council is required to state and certify that all individual contracts awarded during the past year, which involve a transfer of staff, comply, where applicable, with the requirements in the Code of Practice on Workforce Matters in Local Authority Service Contracts.

South Norfolk Council transferred four members of staff to Saffron Housing Partnership during the financial year 2005-06 and can confirm that the transfer complied with the Code of Practice.
