

## **South Norfolk Local Development Framework**

### **Norwich Research Park Development Framework Supplementary Planning Document (SPD), March 2009**

#### **Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, as amended, notice is given that South Norfolk Council adopted the 'Norwich Research Park Development Framework Supplementary Planning Document' (Norwich Research Park SPD) on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2009.

#### **What is the Norwich Research Park SPD?**

Local Development Framework (LDF) is the overall title for a group of related documents that will guide future planning for the District. The Norwich Research Park SPD is part of this group of documents. The SPD sets out the broad framework for the future development of the Norwich Research Park allocation, elaborating on the saved policies of the South Norfolk Local Plan (March 2003). The SPD is adopted following formal consultation on a draft SPD between 21<sup>st</sup> May and 29<sup>th</sup> June 2007.

In accordance with Regulation 16 (2) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, as amended, any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months after 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2009.
