



## **South Norfolk Local Development Framework Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) Adoption Statement**

In accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that South Norfolk Council adopted the Statement of Community Involvement on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2007.

### **What is the Statement of Community Involvement?**

Local Development Framework (LDF) is the overall title for a group of related documents that will guide planning for the District. The Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) is one of this group of documents. The SCI sets out how we will consult the community and other interested parties when preparing the other documents that make up the Local Development Framework. It sets out who we want to involve, the techniques we intend to use and how we plan to use and feed back the information.

An independent Inspector, appointed by the Government, undertook an assessment into the 'soundness' of the SCI and reported back to the Council on 29<sup>th</sup> November 2006. A copy of the Inspector's binding report is available at the locations listed below, including the Statement of Community Involvement section of the Council's website [www.south-norfolk.gov.uk](http://www.south-norfolk.gov.uk).

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power or that a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications should be made within six weeks from 21<sup>st</sup> February 2007.

Any person aggrieved by the SCI may also apply to the High Court for permission to apply for a judicial review of the decision to adopt the Statement. Any such statement should be made promptly and in any case not later than three months from 21<sup>st</sup> February 2007.

### **Where can I see a copy of the Statement of Community Involvement?**
