I was disturbed to hear that there may be boundary changes so that we would be placed in the Costessey tax band and not Bawburgh, as we currently are.

I don't have any objection to paying more, which would be required if we were swapped to Costessey, but I would expect to receive something more for the increased sum.

At the moment, I am disappointed in the service we receive from the council. Those of us who live in the Hampdens/Fairfield Park have needed support in dealing with Green Belt, and many have contacted the council, but the council seems to have declined to help us or to fully adopt this area.

As you already know, the developers of the Hampdens/Fairfield Park tied us into an expensive contract with Green Belt. Green Belt keep increasing their charges but do not properly take care of or fix the green areas or playgrounds. Many of us have complained to them, to no avail. We would like to get out of this contract, and for that we need support from the council.

So to not have received this help and then to be told our taxes may go up is rather galling.

I would rather stay in Bawburgh, and of course I would like to receive support in getting out of the contract with Green Belt.
