



## **The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information (England) Regulations 2012**

### **Notice of Private Meeting**

Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) Meetings and Access to Information (England) Regulations 2012 requires 28 clear days notice to be published of the intention to hold a meeting of a decision-making body in private.

Regulation 5 (6) allows, that with the agreement of the Chairman of the relevant Scrutiny Committee, a meeting may be held in private where publication in accordance with Regulation 5 is impracticable.

The Chairman of the Scrutiny Committee has agreed that the following item can be considered in private session at the Cabinet meeting on 10 December 2018:

### **Proposed Sale of Commercial Property**

This report will be exempt on the grounds that it contains commercially sensitive information by virtue of paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.

This report cannot wait until the next meeting of the Cabinet on 7 January 2019 as this will delay the buyer's ability to commence work.

Notice is therefore hereby given under Regulation 5(7) to hold part of a meeting of the Cabinet on Monday 10 December 2018 in private, to consider the report entitled "Proposed Sale of Commercial Property"
